Most Recent Wildfire Incident:

Cabin Lake (White River Forest)

- Location: Meeker Colorado, Aug-Sept 2018
- Duration; 34 days worked closely with two Type 2 Teams
Rocky Mountain Incident Management “Blue” Team
Southern Area Coordination Center IMT 2 “Gold Team”
- 34 Days with over 20,000 meals served
- Received Gold Team’s “Award Medal for Excellence”

Sunset Grill was called back by the “Gold” Team 5 days later to support the Cabin Lake fire. We worked with the Gold team as the camp transitioned from a Type 2 to a Type 3 incident. During this period (the first 3 days) the camp personal was approximately 300. This 2nd call duration was 17 days

Trail Mountain (Manti-Lasal National Forest)

- Location: Orangeville, Utah, June 2018
- Duration; 2 days prior to Type 2 Team arrival
- 36 hour rapid response serving hot food
- Supported high fluctuations in crew size; original order of 150 Increased to 255 within a two hour notice

Hurricane Harvey (Texas)

- Location: Lumberton, Texas, Sept 2017
- Duration; 6 days ~5,500 meals
- 72 hour rapid response (1,200+ mi) serving hot food
- 6 day volunteer support for Hurricane Harvey evacuees

Round Fire (Gila National Forrest)

- Location: Truth or Consequences, NM, June 2017
- Duration; 17 days ~5,000 meals
- 48 hour rapid response (600+ mi) serving hot food
- Proved ability to support a long term incident

Sheep Canyon Bookcliffs

- Location: Bookcliffs, UT. June 2017
- Duration; 5 days ~1,500 meals
- Duel Fire supported this incident while also feeding the Causeway Fire (250 mi separation)
- Received Utah State wildfire catering contract (3 year)

Causeway (BLM)

- Location: Blanding, Utah June 2017
- Mobilization directly from Baca Fire
- Served hot meals in less then 14 hours
- Total meals count ~1,000 meals
- Was reassigned to Sheep Canyon Fire while supporting this incid

Baca (2nd call)

- Location: Gila NF, Quemado NM, May 2017
- Duration, 8 Days ~3,200 meals
- Severe weather: thunderstorms, snow, winds, muddy/rugged terrain 4x4

Baca (1st Call)

- Location: Gila NF, Quemado NM, May 2017
- Remote Location in the mountains ~ 8,200 ft elevation
- Duration 2 days, ~ 800 meal

Snake Fire (Medicine Bow NF)

- Location: Medicine Bow NF, Wyoming Sept 2016
- Duration; 10 days & 4,000+ meals
- Fire Camp - very remote location - mountain terrain

Patmos & Cottonwood Ridge Fires – Book Cliffs

- Location: Book Cliffs UT, July 2014
- Duration; 7 days & 925 meals
- Fire Camp - very rugged 4x4 mountain terrain

Slope Fire (BLM)

- Location: Millard County UT, June 2014
- Duration; 2 days & 718meals
- Rapid response on site within 14 hours ~340 miles

Sinbad

- Location: La Sal Mountains, July 2013
- Duration; 5 day ~1,400 meals
- Support 3 spike camps, 2 heli

Lucky Fan (IMT 2 Wilde)

- Location: La Sal Mountains, June 2013
- Duration; 1 day & 810 meals (fire crew size 270)
- Supported incident prior to Type II team arrival

Little Pine

- Location: Enterprise UT, August 2012
- Duration; 6 days & 2,588 meals
- Provided a high 280 meals within 4 hour notification
- Supported 2 cold spike camps

Wildfire History Details (cont.)

Little Sands (NIMO Team)

- Location: Pagosa Springs, CO. July 2012
- ~ 500 miles from home base,
- Duration 10 days
- Total meals count 2,770 meals; along with a hot spike camp
- Relocated fire camp in 6 hrs and then supported 143 dinners

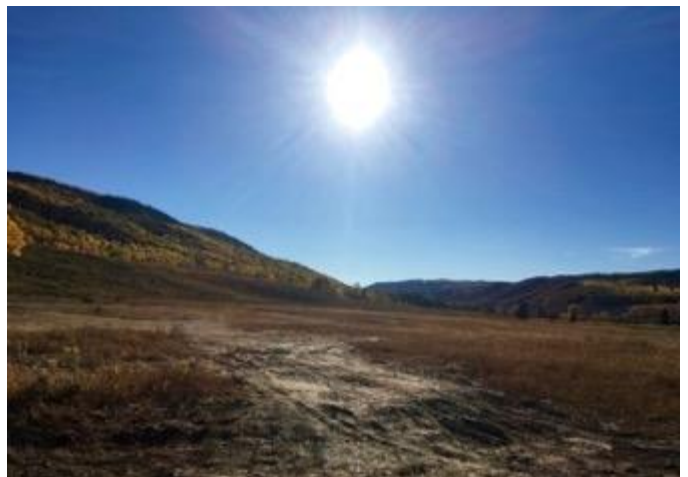
